When you receive this letter we will be in Haiti along with 22 other Christians. The opportunities for us to serve the Lord in this country are tremendous.

The Haitians are a warm and loving people who are open to the Gospel: many of them already love the Lord. However, this country is extremely poor and their needs are great.

On Thanksgiving Day, November 26, 1981, we will be in Zetoit, Haiti. We have learned that there are no known organizations helping these people. Pray for them.

We will be bringing agricultural tools, seeds, clothing, Gospel literature and helpful supplies into the country.

This mission group is made up of Christians from several churches including 9 Haitians from Boston. We are glad to have these native Haitians along with us. Their presence will help us communicate and work with the people of Haiti.

Your prayers on our behalf will be much appreciated.

Upon our return we will be glad to share with you what the Lord has done on this trip.
